Early conversations

We have been reaching out to some landholders in the Crookwell region as part of gauging interest in hosting wind turbines but we have yet to sign any contracts as it is very early days.

If these discussions were to progress into a project, our next step would be to seek feedback from the community. Community input is highly valued to our team as we intentionally design our projects with a focus on the communities we work in.

Every Stromlo Energy project includes a Community Benefit Package aimed at sharing project benefits with the community around our projects. This would include a community benefits fund, a nearby neighbour program for houses within 3.5km of turbines and ongoing contributions to local Council.

How we approach people

Once we identify areas that may be suitable for hosting wind turbines, we use publicly available information to find out who owns the land and to find a contact number for the landholder. If we can't find a contact number, we sometimes ask members of the community if they know how to contact a landholder.

We call the landholder to see if they are potentially interested in hosting turbines, and if they would like to meet with us. There is no obligation for a landholder to meet with us if they do not wish to. We keep the details of any meetings confidential. Anyone we meet with is free to discuss anything with family, friends and other members of the community.
